## 2022 ILBA Honorable Mention Books Worth Your Consideration

This is the second year we are including a list of Honorable Mention Books to go along with our Gold, Silver, and Bronze Medal winners. These selections are a salute to the wide variety of quality books being created BY and ABOUT Latinos, both inside and outside the USA.

As the Empowering Latino Futures Vice President of Authors Katharine A. Díaz put it, "The International Latino Book Awards judges were in a quandary. There are so many top-notch books entered for consideration in many categories, but only a few books can win the top Gold, Silver, and Bronze Medals in each category. So, we have prepared a list of other books that are award-quality and that deserve your attention, too."

Although these books received respectable scores, they are in the 'Honorable Mention' category for one of the following reasons: Many titles are in categories with several exceptional entries. Others have good quality or content and are noteworthy, but the judges felt they still face basic format issues or problems with the presentation, possibly including editing, translation, and grammar errors. Some may need help on the layout or design of the book. Still, these books deserve to be read and added to collections.

When the actor Edward James Olmos and Kirk Whisler co-founded in 1997 what is now the 501c3 nonprofit **Empowering Latino Futures**, we saw the organization as both a facilitator for Latinos to have more access to a multitude of resources to help improve their futures AND a way to help mainstream America view the Latino community in more accurate, less stereotypical ways. Over the last two and a half decades, our collective accomplishments include:

- ✓ Holding 69 **Latino Book & Family Festivals** around the USA, with a combined attendance of 900,000+ people;
- ✓ Honoring 3,470 books via the **International Latino Book Awards**;
- ✓ Producing and distributing 182,500 copies of the **National Latino & American Indian Scholarship Directory**;
- ✓ Distributing 165,000+ books to underserved youth in North San Diego County via **Education Begins in the Home**; and
- ✓ Honoring 155 books via the **Latino Books into Movies Awards**.

## 2021 ILBA Mención Honorifica Libros dignos de su consideración

Este es el segundo año que incluimos una lista de libros con mención honorífica para acompañar a nuestros ganadores de medallas de oro, plata y bronce. Estas selecciones son un homenaje a la amplia variedad de libros destacados por y acerca de latinos, tanto dentro como fuera de los EE. UU.

Como lo dijo la vicepresidenta de autores de Empowering Latino Futures, Katharine A. Díaz, "los jueces de los reconocimientos internacionales de libro latino entraron en un dilema. Hubo muchos libros sobresalientes y dignos de su consideración en muchas categorías, pero solo unos pocos pueden recibir las medallas. Por eso, hemos preparado una lista libros que ameritan ser reconocidos y que también merecen su atención".

Aunque estos libros recibieron marcas decentes, se les ha colocado en la categoría de 'Mención Honorífica' por una de las siguientes razones: Muchos títulos están en categorías con varios concursantes excepcionales. Otros tienen una calidad o un contenido destacado, pero los jueces sienten que aún enfrentan problemas con la presentación, lo que posiblemente podría incluir errores de edición, traducción o gramática. Algunos podrían requerir de ayuda con el diseño. Aún así, estos libros merecen ser leídos y agregados a las colecciones.

Cuando el actor Edward James Olmos y Kirk Whisler cofundaron en 1997 lo que ahora es la organización sin fines de lucro 501c3 **Empowering Latino Futures**, percibieron a la organización como un facilitador para que los latinos tuvieran más acceso a una multitud de recursos para ayudar a mejorar su futuro y para ayudar a la cultura popular en Estados Unidos a ver a la comunidad latina de manera más precisa y menos estereotipada.

## THE 24TH INTERNATIONAL LATINO BOOK AWARDS FINALISTS: WINNING BOOKS SHOWCASE GROWING TALENT

The International Latino Book Awards reflect the strength and talent of the fastest-growing group in the USA. By far the largest Latino cultural Awards in the country, they have honored the greatness of 3,470 authors and publishers over the past two decades. This year the Awards boast 249 finalists in 108 categories, numbers that underscore the high demand for books by and about Latinos. In 2022, Latinos will purchase over \$750 million in books in English and Spanish.

The 2022 Finalists for the 24th Annual International Latino Book Awards showcase the growing quality of books by and about Latinos. About 40% of the winners were from major U.S. and international publishers, 22% from medium-sized publishing houses, and 38% from small publishing houses or even self-published. To handle this large number of titles, the Awards counted on 217 judges in 2022. They shared how hard their task was, because so many great books are being published now. Judges included librarians, educators, media professionals, leaders of national organizations, Pulitzer Prize Winners, and even elected officials. The Awards celebrate books in English, Spanish and Portuguese, and the Finalists are from across the USA and Puerto Rico, as well as 21 other countries. These Awards are produced by Empowering Latino Futures, a 501c3 nonprofit cofounded by the actor Edward James Olmos and Kirk Whisler in 1997. We launched the organization as both a facilitator for Latinos to have more access to a multitude of resources to help improve their futures AND a way to help mainstream America view the Latino community in more accurate, less stereotypical ways. Over the last two and a half decades, our collective accomplishments include:

- ✓ Holding 69 **Latino Book & Family Festivals** around the USA, with a combined attendance of 900,000+ people;
- ✓ Honoring 3,470 books via the **International Latino Book Awards**;
- ✓ Producing and distributing 182,500 copies of the **National Latino & American Indian Scholarship Directory**;
- ✓ Distributing 165,000+ books to underserved youth in North San Diego County via **Education Begins in the Home**; and
- ✓ Honoring 155 books via the **Latino Books into Movies Awards**.

Los International Latino Book Awards reflejan la fuerza y el talento del grupo que más rápido está creciendo en Estados Unidos. Ahora estos Premios culturales más grandes del país han reconocido la grandeza de 3,470 autores y casas editoriales en las últimas dos décadas. Este año los Premios presentan 249 finalistas en 108 categorías, cifras que resaltan la demanda de libros por y para los latinos. En 2022, los latinos gastarán más de \$750 millones en libros en inglés y español.

Los finalistas de este año muestran la creciente calidad de los libros escritos por y para Latinos. Una tercera parte de los ganadores pertenece a las principales casas editoriales en Estados Unidos y mercados internacionales, una tercera parte a casas editoriales de tamaño medio, y la última tercera parte pertenece a editoriales pequeñas o está conformada de libros auto-publicados. Este año 2022, 217 jueces participaron en el proceso de evaluación de todos los libros participantes. Los jueces compartieron que no fue un proceso fácil el elegir a los ganadores, debido a la gran calidad de todos los libros. Los jueces estuvieron conformados por bibliotecarios, educadores, profesionales de los medios, líderes de organizaciones nacionales, ganadores de Pulitzer Prize y hasta oficiales electos. Los reconocimientos incluyen libros escritos en inglés, español y portugués y los finalistas son de alrededor de Estados Unidos y Puerto Rico, así como de 21 países más.

Cuando el actor Edward James Olmos y Kirk Whisler cofundaron en 1997 lo que ahora es la organización sin fines de lucro 501c3 **Empowering Latino Futures**, percibieron a la organización como un facilitador para que los latinos tuvieran más acceso a una multitud de recursos para ayudar a mejorar su futuro y para ayudar a la cultura popular en Estados Unidos a ver a la comunidad latina de manera más precisa y menos estereotipada.

- ✓ La celebración de 69 festivales latinos del libro y la familia en los EE.UU., con una asistencia combinada de 900,000+ people;
- ✓ Se han honrado 3,470 libros a través de los International Latino Book Awards;
- ✓ Se han producido y distribuido 182,500 copias del Directorio Nacional de Becas para Indígenas Latinos y Americanos;
- ✓ Se han distribuido más de 165,000 libros a jóvenes desatendidos en el norte del condado de San Diego, a través de Education Begins in the Home;
- ✓ Se han reconocido 155 libros a través de los premios Latino Books into Movies.
